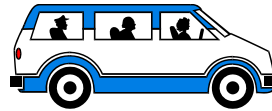
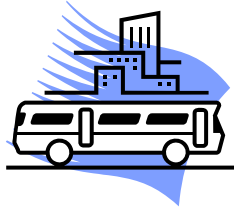


Travel Reduction Plan - Maricopa County, AZ REGISTRATION & DRAWING FORM

Sign-up to be an Alternative Mode User (AMU). This is a person who carools, vanpools, teleworks, rides a bicycle, takes the bus, walks to and from work, or uses light rail. First-time AMUs will be placed in a quarterly drawing to receive a \$5.00 STAR card, limited to the first 20 new AMUs. If you decide to become an AMU, you will be eligible for several benefits that are not offered to your co-workers who drive alone to work.

- Use an alternative mode of transportation and you will be placed in a *MONTHLY* drawing for a \$20 Sprouts gift card (*taxable benefit).
- Employees who use alternative modes of transportation can submit one entry per week. At the end of each month six winners will be randomly selected.
- As a registered AMU, Sprouts offers a Guaranteed Ride Home Program to get you home via a co-worker or taxi in the event of an emergency. This program is limited to two uses per year – once every six months.
- Free bus card for AMU Sprouts employees – Sprouts will pay a 100% of the bus card for employees who want to take the bus to and from work. Employees who ride their bike to work can park their bike inside the store.
